ADULT ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE IN PERSON:

To enroll, please report in person to one of the offices listed below. If you fail to enroll **WITHIN 60 DAYS** from your court date (unless otherwise ordered by the Court), your case will be referred back to Court as a **failure to enroll**. Failure to enroll may result in a bench warrant being issued. If you have a medical or physical limitation (see below) you must enroll at the main office. To enroll you **MUST** bring the following:

- ⇒ **COURT ORDER ISSUED BY COURT**
- ⇒ **PICTURE I.D.**
- ⇒ **NON-REFUNDABLE ENROLLMENT FEE OF \$59.00 FOR ADULTS (EXACT AMOUNT)**
(JUVENILES ARE NO LONGER ELIGIBLE FOR THE WORK PROJECTS PROGRAM)

CASH (EXACT AMOUNT), MONEY ORDER (PAYABLE TO: SAN DIEGO COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT), VISA AND MASTERCARD ARE ACCEPTED AT ALL LOCATIONS. CONSECUTIVE ADULT CASES ARE \$59.00 EACH AND CONCURRENT ADULT CASES ARE CHARGED ONE FEE, \$59.00 FOR BOTH. **PERSONAL CHECKS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**

MEDICAL/PHYSICAL LIMITATIONS

In order to ensure the safety and well-being of all public service workers you must be in good health to participate in public service work. Manual labor is a required component of the Work Projects Program. If you state that you have physical or medical limitations, you may be issued a work projects medical evaluation form to submit to your doctor for completion. If your medical/physical limitations are minor or not permanent, you can enroll in the program and be assigned to a work crew when your restrictions are lifted. If your doctor states that your limitations can be accommodated on a regular crew you will be assigned and required to comply with your doctor's orders. If your limitations cannot be accommodated on a regular crew you will be required, upon written notice, to appear in court within seven (7) days (pursuant to Cal. Penal Code §1203.3). If you have accommodated medical/physical limitations, you must enroll at the Main Office.
