Pursuant to San Diego Superior Court Rules, rule 6.3.3B, "Each attorney who has been certified by the court will submit a new Certification of Competency to the court on or before January 31st of the same year in which the attorney must certify MCLE credits to the State Bar of California." The deadline of January 31st was intended to coincide with the deadline set by the State Bar of California for attorneys to report MCLE compliance.

In November 2024, the State Bar revised its policy to extend the reporting deadline to March 30, 2025, for Compliance Group 1 (attorneys with last names starting with A-G) and to extend the reporting deadlines for Compliance Groups 2 and 3 to March 30th of the year in which their MCLE compliance must be reported to the State Bar. The State Bar announced this change in policy in November 2024, several months after the deadline for amending San Diego Superior Court rules to become effective on January 1, 2025.

## FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- Each attorney who has been certified by the court will submit a new Certification of Competency to the court on or before March 30<sup>th</sup> of the same year in which the attorney must certify MCLE credits to the State Bar of California.
- 2. This Order revises San Diego Superior Court rule 6.3.3B for the calendar year 2025 and expires on December 31, 2025.
