Annual CME Declaration

Declaration regarding Continuing Mediation Education training as stated in Section II.C.4. of the Mediator Manual: “Complete at least four (4) hours of approved Continuing Mediation Education (CME) credits annually. The CME must focus on mediation skills, process, and standards, and at least one of the four hours must focus on ethical issues. CME Credits may also be satisfied by facilitating a CME course that is at least two (2) hours in length. At least one (1) hour of the course must focus on ethics while the other hour may focus on mediation skills, process and standards.”

1. I have completed the required four (4) hours of CME **OR** facilitated a (2) hour CME course to continue to participate in the San Diego Superior Court Mediation Program. In order to qualify, training must have been completed on or before February 2023. If training completed in 2022 was used to satisfy the 2021 CME requirement, those same credits *cannot* also be used to satisfy the 2022 CME requirement.
